Dear Friend,

Thank you for everything that you do in serving the community and for considering partnering with Without Walls in breaking the cycle of dependency by restoring hope, viability, and self-sufficiency to the forlorn of Charleston’s inner city community.

There are over 100,000 people living at or below the poverty level in the Charleston, SC MSA. Given the fact that there are also 10,000 plus homeless people in the state of South Carolina at any given time – and that hunger and homelessness are on the rise – we all need to do our share. One powerful way to make a big difference in this area is to invest in WithOut Walls (WOW). WOW is a non-profit, 501(3)(c) organization that is a conglomeration of churches, businesses, and social service agencies with a 14-year proven track record of not only addressing the immediate needs, but also giving people the training and the tools to rise up, break the cycle of dependency, and become self- reliant.

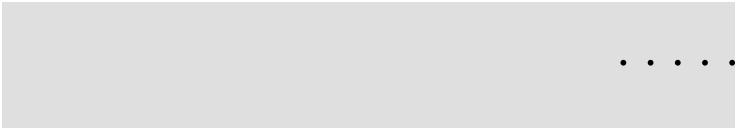
A representation of a sampling of services provided by Without Walls Ministry, in conjunction with Hope Assembly of God Church and Man-city (year-long, faith-based residential training program for men with life controlling challenges):

- A 14-year track record of meeting needs and teaching self- reliance
- Distribution of an average of 2,000 lbs of food per week
- Mentoring of children in 10 adopted inner city neighborhoods
- Teaching organic gardening to adults and children in adopted neighborhoods
- Setting up critically needed outreach and support groups in adopted neighborhoods
- Facilitating a one year faith-based residential program for men with life-controlling problems
- Free breakfasts, showers, clothing, use of laundry facilities, bill payment, referrals and more weekly events that provide free medical and dental care and screenings, haircuts, job fairs, and community services
- Organization and implementation of the annual Convoy of Hope – the second largest annual one-day event in Charleston – where we feed, clothe, offer medical assistance, haircuts, job fair, etc., with 10,000+ participants and 200+ volunteers.
- “Back-to-school-Bash” where we annually distribute 500 bags of school supplies and 500 school uniforms
- 1,000 annual Christmas Day meals, 500 annual Thanksgiving meals
- Recovery programs such as NA (Narcotics Anonymous, a 12-step recovery program) and Celebrate Recovery (faith-based 12-step recovery program).

“I was reached by a worker. I lived in a crack house as an addict. I now have my own place and coordinate ministry Fridays at the church. I have jobs and am on fire for God!” *Lorraine*

“Without Walls came to my apartment daily. I was suffering from manic-depression. I was isolated from my family and lacked direction. I am now in school and my family has contacted me. This year was the first time in 5 years that my brother contacted me on my birthday!” *Tricia*



“I was reached through a Without Walls worker. I had no job and was struggling depression. I attended an event and surrendered to God. Now, I work at a school and am the director of all food services for Without Walls!” *Vermelle*

“My mom was saved through people reaching outside the four walls. She stopped drinking and started serving in the community. Her life was different. Even though she recently passed away from cancer, I am involved in church, outreaches and a weekly Without Walls group in the apartment complex I live in downtown. I have obtained a college degree and am now working.” *Miesha*

“I was living on the streets for 8 years. Since being reached, I now have a full time job and a place to stay. I work in the ministry daily, meeting the needs of people as they come into the center for help.” *Alonzo*

“I was addicted to crack, meth and alcohol. I had been homeless for 4 years. Without Walls reached out to me during one of their events, and I am now am on staff at the men’s facility.” *Clayton*

“Someone told me I could receive free groceries at the ministry center. I came and gave my life to Jesus. I did not have a job and was struggling. God cleaned me up and put me on solid ground. I am now married and have moved to Ladson and am renting a house!” *Calettia*

“I came to an event to get a ham to sell for heroine. I was homeless. I am now the head usher at my church!!!” *Tommy*

Without Walls has been meeting physical and spiritual needs of Charlestonians for years now and doing so out of 15,000 square feet of rented space. We have outgrown our facilities and need a permanent location downtown. We are currently looking at a property on which we could build a warehouse and a shelter for veterans. We need \$100,000 by the end of March and this golf tournament will serve as a great vehicle for helping us reach that goal.

As you know, Without Walls is a 501(c)(3) non- profit organization. We will provide a “gift-in-kind” receipt—along with placing your company on our sponsor board—for any money and/or goods donated. Subject to your approval, we can also place your logo on a “special recognition” board we have and would be happy to display any company banner you might have. Any business giving goods, services or finances will also be thanked publicly based on the value of the charitable contribution (please contact me for specific details). The “special recognition” board is displayed at our ministry center and is also displayed at all of our major events.
